CUSTOMER/CARRIER CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The customer is responsible for preparing the vehicle for transport. Including: disarming any alarm systems (keys must also be provided to any alarm system), removing any loose parts, protruding accessories, low hanging spoilers, etc. Any part of the vehicle that falls off during transportation is the customer's responsibility including damages caused to any and all other vehicles involved.
2. The vehicle owner or customer must, in their absence, designate a person to act as their agent at the point of pickup and/or delivery, if for any reason they are unavailable. If customer requests to drop without signature it is at shippers own risk. NO EXCEPTIONS.
3. The transporter will not be responsible for any exhaust systems, mufflers, or tail pipes, any mechanical function damage to include engine, transmission, rear end, motor mounts, drive trains, wiring systems, cooling systems, window motors, radios, stereo systems, power steering, air bag, brake system, clutch cable or clutch, vehicle computerized components, alarm systems, (anything mechanical or electrical) NO EXCEPTIONS.
4. The transporter will not be responsible for damage caused by freezing of engine, cooling system, batteries or due to leaking fluids.
5. The customer verifies the vehicle is free of contents.
6. The transporter will not be responsible for any convertible tops that are loose, torn, or have visible wear, vehicle boots, caps, masks, bras, or any other type of canvas or material covering. NO EXCEPTIONS.
7. Exceptions for damage must be noted on the inspection report at time of delivery. A claim for damage not documented on the inspection report will not be honored. The driver is in no way allowed to or is given permission to alter the inspection report in any way. NO EXCEPTIONS.
8. Any and all claims must be made in writing within fifteen (15) days of delivery along with two (2) estimates. Any and all claims reported after the fifteen (15) days will be denied. NO EXCEPTIONS.
9. The shipper has the primary insurance responsibility.
10. Shipper is responsible for preparing vehicle for shipment.
11. There will be no auto rental for damage, delays or accidents.
12. Damage caused by Acts of God, Vandalism, or the Authority of the law.
13. The transporter is not responsible for damage to tires (cuts, puncturing, scrapes, etc.)
14. The transporter is not responsible for damage to interior such as dash boards, rugs, seats, etc., as interiors are not inspected.
15. Antennas that do not retract less than three (3) inches above the mounted area. Removal is the responsibility of the shipper.
16. Loss and or damage to articles or personal belongings left in vehicle.
17. The transporter is not responsible for damage to undercarriage due to being overloaded.
18. The customer agrees that if the payment cannot be made at time of delivery, the vehicle will be stored at the customer's expense.
19. If a truck is sent to acquire the vehicle and it is not there or is unavailable or has been moved, or cannot be picked up for any other reason an additional \$100.00 fee will be added to the transport cost.
20. Customer agrees that if this vehicle becomes inoperative for any reason during transport, a \$150.00 winch fee will be added to the transport charge and will be collected at time of delivery. This charge must be paid by cash or cashier's check. NO EXCEPTIONS.
21. The liability of carrier and its agent for loss or damage to the vehicle or contents under either limited or any extended coverage purchased by the shipper shall be in excess of any insurance the owner or shipper has in effect covering the vehicle.
22. The transporter is not responsible for damage to glass or T-tops due to body flexing, or heat build up.
23. The transporter is not responsible for damage to any car that cannot be driven on or off carrier under its own power, or with no brakes or parking gear. Service charge to jump start or tow on or off carrier.
24. Delivery of any particular schedule. Contract or carriage is governed by terms and conditions of the Uniform Straight Bill of Lading.
25. The transporter is not responsible for damage resulting from failure of factory tie down brackets or pull through of frame tie holes.
26. Customer must remove any bug deflectors, sunroof deflectors, or window reflectors before shipping. Damage caused to customers vehicle or any other vehicle by such items is solely the responsibility of the customer.
27. SOUTHERN AUTO TRANSPORT SERVICES, INC. does not guarantee delivery on any particular schedule.
28. All claims under this Agreement, subrogation, legal litigation or legal action must have a venue in the State of Florida, County of Manatee, United States of America. In any event, if the provision concerning jurisdiction in the County of Manatee, State of Florida is deemed invalid or otherwise unenforceable, all litigation must be in the State of Florida, United States of America, under venue provisions of the State of Florida.
